## on Designating the sites awarded the European Heritage Label 2021

### THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Decision N° 1194/2011/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 November 2011 establishing a European Union action for the European Heritage Label<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 14(1) thereof,

#### Whereas:

- (1) On 8 December 2021, the European panel transmitted to the Commission its report regarding the selection process of sites for the attribution of the European Heritage Label in 2021 and, taking into account its recommendations, the Commission should designate the sites to be awarded the label.
- (2) Pursuant to Article 15 of Decision No 1194/2011/EU, each site awarded the label should be monitored on a regular basis in order to ensure that it continues to meet those criteria and that it respects the project and work plan submitted in its application for the selection,
